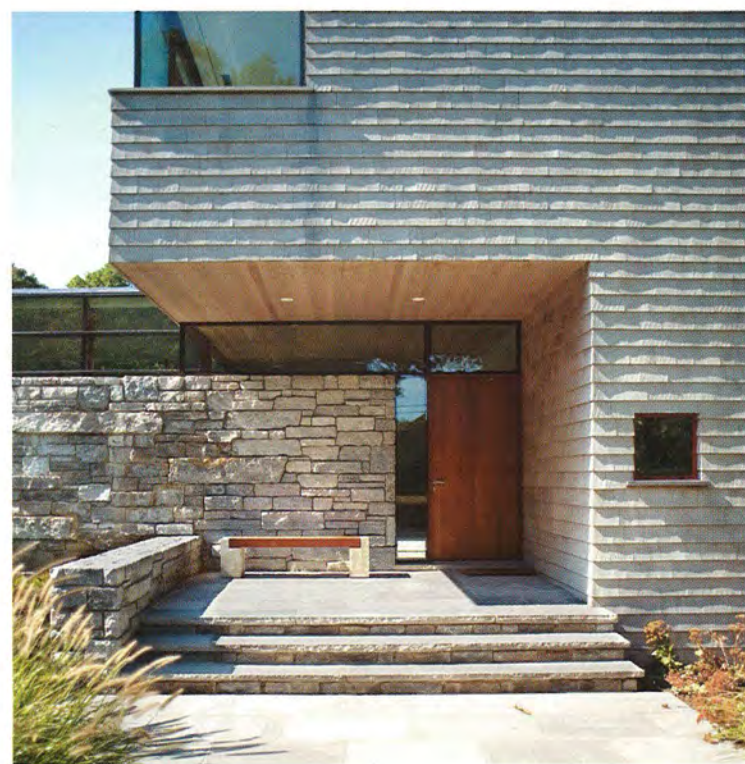

Barnes Coy Architects
Georgica Pond Residence

This project's distinct challenge, not unusual for the East End, was a site on a waterfront/wetland lot on Georgica Creek, which mandated a small, oddly shaped building envelope. The clients, a family with two young children, wanted public and private areas, a request Barnes Coy Architects met with two asymmetrical wings positioned at right angles to either end of the main open space. One wing contains the kitchen and children's and guest rooms; the other the master suite. These wings meet in a 14-foot-high glass box, the main living space, which is parallel to the view of the pond. Materials used, such as cedar shingles and siding and Pennsylvania stone, are sensitive to the historic character of the area while looking thoroughly modern at the same time. Judge Paul Goldberger described this project as "quirky but intriguing, a nice solution to a complex site—and it's great to see a large house on Georgica Pond without a shingled gambrel roof." Charlotte Moss added, "It's both heavy and light, and feels anchored to and integrated with the landscape." The builder is Ben Krupinski and the interior designer is Frank de Biasi.
